

Pay offer wholly inadequate



On Monday 4 December, the NASUWT met representatives of the Sixth Form Colleges Association (SFCA), the colleges' national body, to resume discussions on the sixth-form college teachers' annual pay award from September 2017.

The NASUWT strongly asserted that detailed information it had provided to the meeting about pay progression, workforce distribution and the reserves held by sixth-form colleges demonstrated clearly that the Employers' Side could increase their earlier pay offer of 1% on all scale points and allowances from 1 September 2017.

The Employers' Side responded that it was not able to increase the pay offer.

The NASUWT expressed its deep disappointment and again rejected the offer as wholly inadequate. Following discussion, it was agreed that the Employers' Side would consider the points made by the NASUWT, and the NASUWT would consult members before pay negotiations resumed in January 2018.
